#### 1. Introduction

#### **Objectives of the Scheme**

The objective of the scheme is to involve special purpose vehicles in export effort by providing assistance to the PSU under State Government / GoI, export promotion councils/commodity boards /recognized apex trade body under EXIM policy of GoI & export oriented individual manufacturing / services enterprises for creating appropriate infrastructure for development and growth of exports. Such involvement will be based on the projectised approach and projects are to be prioritized by GoUP to address the critical link both at the point of processing and the point of evacuation in the industrial cluster, largely within the contour of the first mile and the last mile consideration.

#### 1.1 Requests for Proposal

Export Promotion Bureau invites applications for implementation, operation and maintenance of Projects selected under NAVY Scheme to undertake the assignment as defined on the Terms and Conditions mentioned in this document.

#### 1.2 Procurement of Document

#### 1.3 Validity of the Proposal

The Proposal shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the due date of submitting of the proposal.

#### 1.4 Brief description

- 1.4.1. The applicant may apply for the enlisted projects in para-5 with a maximum capping of. Rs 10.00 Cr. per project exposure (excluding the cost of land) considering state assistance of 70% under the NAVY scheme to the total cost of project as competent assessment. The cost of encumbrance free land shall be borne by the applicant. The applicant's proposals shall be evaluated on the basis of comprehensive detailing of its quality and its due impact on exports.
- 1.4.2. Applicants, whose total cost is more than that of the specified limit should note that the assistance under the scheme is limited as given in para 1.4.1. Such applicants, if

selected, shall have to bear the additional cost by themselves.

#### 2. Selection Process.

- 2. 1 . All applications shall be submitted to the Deputy Commissioner, District Industries Promotion And Entrepreneurship Development Centres of the concerned district where the project is proposed upto ......under separate sealed cover for each project indicating the name of project in the front of envelope. Additionally, the proposals can also be directly submitted in the office of the Export Promotion Bureau ,8-Cantt Road, Lucknow by the due date .
- 2.2. Deputy Commissioner, District Industries Promotion And Entrepreneurship Development Centres shall deliver all applications, received in their offices, in sealed cover to Export Promotion Bureau on .........
- 2.4. After examining the applications, if required, the screening committee may ask the applicant for presentation of the project, on a separate date which shall be intimated separately. Final report will be presented to SLEPC after evaluation.
- 2.5. Decision taken by SLEPC will be final and binding.

#### 7. Right to reject any or all Proposals

- 8.1 Notwithstanding anything contained in this document, the SLEPC reserves the right to accept or reject any Proposal and to annul the Selection Process and reject all Proposals, at any time without any liability or any obligation for such acceptance rejection or annulment, and without assigning any reasons thereof.
- 8.2 Applications are liable to be rejected if:
  - (a) at any time, a material misrepresentation is made or uncovered, or
  - (b) The applicant does not provide, within the time specified the supplementary information sought for evaluation of the Proposal.
- 8.3 Such misrepresentation/ improper response may lead to the disqualification of the applicant.

#### 8. Clarifications

#### **10.0** Amendment / Modification

- 11.2 While submitting the Proposal, the applicant shall, in particular, ensure that Power of Attorney for signing of proposal have been submitted;

- 11.3 The EXPORT PROMOTION BUREAU reserves the right to verify all statements, information and documents, submitted by the applicant in response to the proposal.
- 11.4 The applicant shall submit the Proposal in hard bound form with all pages numbered serially and by giving an index of submissions. Each page of the submission shall be signed by indelible ink by the Authorized Representative.
- 11.5 The Proposal will be sealed in an outer envelope bearing the address of the concerned Deputy Commissioner, District Industries Promotion And Entrepreneurship Development Centres, or Export Promotion Bureau, 8 cantt road, Lucknow depending upon the office to which the application is being submitted along with the name and address of the applicant. The envelope should be clearly marked as "Proposal Under Niryat Awasthapna Vikas Yojna"
- 11.6 The Proposal shall only be made in the Forms specified in this document. Any attachment to such Forms must be provided on separate sheets of paper and only information that is directly relevant should be provided. This may include photocopies of the relevant pages of printed documents.

#### 12.Proposal Due Date

- 12.1 Proposal should be submitted up to ....... on at the address, provided in para 11.5 in the manner and form as detailed in this document.
- 12.2 The DEPUTY COMMISSIONER or Export Promotion Bureau shall give a receipt of receiving the sealed application cover in the concerned office indicating date and time of receipt and the sequence number of the receipt of application in the office.
- 12.3 The EXPORT PROMOTION BUREAU may, in its sole discretion, extend the Proposal Due Date by issuing a Corrigendum in accordance

#### 13. Modification/ substitution/ withdrawal of Proposals

No Proposal shall be modified, substituted, or withdrawn by the applicant after its submission.

#### 14.Evaluation of Proposals

14.1 Prior to evaluation of Proposals, the EXPORT PROMOTION BUREAU will determine whether each Proposal is responsive to the requirements of the document. A Proposal shall be considered responsive only if submitted on proper application format with all enclosures, Bank Draft of the cost of document; Proof of fee from government organisations is not required.

#### 15. Clarifications

To facilitate evaluation of Proposals, the EXPORT PROMOTION BUREAU may, at its sole discretion, seek clarifications from any applicant regarding its Proposal.

#### 16. Penalty Clause:

16.1 If the progress of assignment is found to be non-satisfactory or delayed at any point of time, Export Promotion Bureau reserves the right to impose penalty. The total amount of penalty shall not exceed 5% of total assigned cost.

#### 17. Objective

The broad objectives of the assignment are:

- 17.1. To create export related infrastructure which has overwhelming impact on growth of export.
- 17.2. To ensure efficient implementation and running of the project.

#### 18. Scope of Work

The Scope of work shall include the following stages:

- 18.1 To Prepare Detailed Project Report within 2 month From the date of approval of the project.
- 18.2 To create export infrastructure as per DPR approved by competent authority within a period of two years from the date of financial sanction.
- 18.3 To implement and run the project and provide the services of infrastructure created under the scheme as per Terms and Condition laid down in agreement

#### 19. Criteria and procedure of approval and evaluation of the project:

19.1 Land free from all encumbrances is prerequisite for consideration of projects for assistance under the scheme.
